### 1. YOUR PAST \_\_\_\_\_ DEFINE YOU

<sup>5</sup> The angel told the women, “Don’t be afraid, because I know you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. <sup>6</sup> He is not here. For he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. Matthew 28:5–6

He was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification. Romans 4:25

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, and see, the new has come! 2 Corinthians 5:17

<sup>8</sup> So, departing quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, they ran to tell his disciples the news. <sup>9</sup> Just then Jesus met them and said, “Greetings!” They came up, took hold of his feet, and worshiped him. Matthew 28:8–9

<sup>9</sup> Just then Jesus met them and said, “Greetings!” They came up, took hold of his feet, and worshiped him. <sup>10</sup> Then Jesus told them, “Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to leave for Galilee, and they will see me there.” Matthew 28:9–10

But as it is, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. 1 Corinthians 15:20

<sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me, even if he dies, will live. <sup>26</sup> Everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?” John 11:25–26
