**1. PEOPLE MUST \_\_\_\_\_**

<sup>2</sup> As they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, “Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.” <sup>3</sup> Then after they had fasted, prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them off. Acts 13:2–3

<sup>2</sup> I will make you into a great nation, I will bless you, I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. <sup>3</sup> I will bless those who bless you, I will curse anyone who treats you with contempt, and all the peoples on earth will be blessed through you. Genesis 12:2–3

<sup>19</sup> Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit... Matthew 28:19

<sup>9</sup> After this I looked, and there was a vast multitude from every nation, tribe, people, and language, which no one could number, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were clothed in white robes with palm branches in their hands. Revelation 7:9

**2. YOU MUST \_\_\_\_\_ THEM**

<sup>14</sup> How, then, can they call on him they have not believed in? And how can they believe without hearing about him? And how can they hear without a preacher? <sup>15</sup> And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: **How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news.** Romans 10:14–15

<sup>15</sup> but in your hearts regard Christ the Lord as holy, ready at any time to give a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you. 1 Peter 3:15

<sup>30</sup> When Philip ran up to it, he heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, “Do you understand what you’re reading?”

<sup>31</sup> “How can I,” he said, “unless someone guides me?” So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him. Acts 8:30–31

<sup>16</sup> For if I preach the gospel, I have no reason to boast, because I am compelled to preach—and woe to me if I do not preach the gospel! 1 Corinthians 9:16

**3. GOD’S GOT YOU \_\_\_\_\_**

<sup>19</sup> Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.” Matthew 28:19–20

<sup>8</sup> This book of instruction must not depart from your mouth; you are to meditate on it day and night so that you may carefully observe everything written in it. For then you will prosper and succeed in whatever you do. <sup>9</sup> Haven’t I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” Joshua 1:8–9

<sup>5</sup> Keep your life free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for he himself has said, **I will never leave you or abandon you.** <sup>6</sup> Therefore, we may boldly say, **The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?** Hebrews 13:5–6

<sup>23</sup> For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23

<sup>9</sup> If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

<sup>10</sup> One believes with the heart, resulting in righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, resulting in salvation. Romans 10:9–10
